He has also collaborated with ensembles such as the Granollers Orchestra of Cambra, Ensemble BCN216, Grupo Instrumental s.XX, Taller Atlántico Contemporáneo, OSG Sinfonietta, Camerata Bocherini, Natalia Ensemble, Quantum Ensemble or the Bal and Gay Festival Ensemble.

He has collaborated with different professional orchestras such as the Gran Teatro del Liceo, the Navarra Symphony Orchestra, the Vallès Symphony Orchestra, the Barcelona and National Symphony Orchestra of Catalonia, the RTVE, the Gulbenkian Orchestra and the Gran Canaria Philharmonic Orchestra.

As a teacher he has been invited as a teacher to the Youth Orchestra of the Galician Symphony, to the Jove Orquestra Nacional de Catalunya and to the Classical Orchestra of Xove in addition to having taken courses in Santiago de Compostela, Rianxo and As Pontes and master classes in Santiago de Compostela, Lalín, Vic, Cádiz and Pamplona.

He is currently a bassoonist for the Galician Symphony Orchestra, where he has worked since 2006 and where he has worked with conductors such as Dima Slobodeniouk, Víctor Pablo Pérez, Jesús López-Cobos, Neville Marriner, Lorin Maazel, Christoph Eschenbach and Gustavo Dudamel among others and with the who has toured South America, Central Europe and the UAE.
