Academic record

Trombonist David Rejano Cantero was born in Badajoz (Spain) and studied music at the Madrid Conservatory.

Later he moved to the Paris National Conservatory of Music and Dance with Professor Gilles Millière, where he graduated with the *Diploma de Formation Supérieure - Mention très bien à la unanimité* and the *Prix Spécial du Jury*.

Professional experience

As a student, David Rejano Cantero was a member of several youth orchestras, including the *Orquesta Nacional de España* (JONDE), The European Union Youth Orchestra and the West-Eastern Divan Orchestra (with Daniel Barenboim and Pierre Boulez).

He has collaborated as a guest trombone at the *Berliner Philharmoniker*, the *Orchester national de France*, *La Orchester de l'Opéra national de Paris* or the *Symphonieorchester December Bayerischen Rundfunks* under the direction of conductors such as Kurt Masur, Valéry Gergiev, Zubin Mehta, Lorin Maazel, Gustavo Dudamel, Daniel Barenboim and Andris Nelsons.

From 2002 to 2007 he was Principal Trombone of the *Orquesta Sinfónica de Navarra*, from 2007 to 2010 Principal Trombone of the *Orquesta del Gran Teatre del Liceu de Barcelona*, and Principal Trombone at the *Münchener Philharmoniker*.

Very active as a teacher, David teaches master classes around the world, in countries such as: Japan, France, Germany, South Korea, Austria, China and Guatemala.

Rejano frequently appears as soloist and teacher at different festivals, such as the *Concours National de Trombone de France*, the *Européen du Trombone Festival* (Strasbourg), the Sapporo Festival, the Summer Brass Festival and the International Trombone Festival.

David Rejano is currently a principal trombone of the Los Angeles Philharmonic.
