In early music, he has received master classes from Jaap Schröder, Barry Sargent and Rinaldo Alesandrini.

Professional Experience

Qualified as a violinist with a great sound, a great presence on stage and a lot of musicality and experience. He has appeared on numerous occasions as a soloist in important Spanish concert halls making recordings on CD, radio, television and cinema.

He has collaborated on numerous occasions with **orchestras** such as the Galicia Symphony, Murcia Symphony, Oviedo City Symphony or the Royal Philharmonic of Galicia.

He has been a professor at the Conservatorio Superior de Vigo and invited to teach masterclasses at various music education centers inside and outside Galicia.

His students have been awarded in international competitions and hold leading positions in young and professional orchestras.

He is currently the first violin of the Camerata Arven and collaborates with the early music group Resonet, with whom he has recently recorded a CD. Together with Arquímedes Artal (viola da gamba) and Femando Reyes (baroque guitar) he forms the Baroque ensemble Teucro Trio.

He is also conductor of the Xove Orquestra Filharmónica Cidade de Pontevedra.
