He is currently a viola teacher at CSM Galicia and plays at the Royal Philharmonic of Galicia.

Academic Record

He began his musical studies at the age of 5 at the Kazan Special School of Music in a violin class with Professor L.S Levitskaya and later with G.H. Hodjaev.

In 1988 he entered the State Conservatory of that city (professors G.H. Hodjaev and B. Kaplun), which ended with the highest marks in 1994, obtaining the diplomas of solo violin, orchestra artist and violin teacher.

Professional Experience

He was Concertino in the **Student Symphony Orchestra** for three years under the direction of **F. Mansurov**.

From 1991 to 1995 he was part of the Chamber Orchestra "La Primavera" in Kazan. In 1994-1995 he played with the Kazan State Philharmonic Orchestra as co-principal in the early violin section. During the summers of 1993 and 1994 he was a member of the Gustav Mahler Jugend Orchester, under the direction of Claudio Abbado, R. Chailly, Sir N. Mariner, among others. In 1995 he moved to Moscow and entered the Moscow Orchestra as co-principal in the first violin section under the direction of R. Freisitzer.

Between 1996 and 1998 he worked in the State Symphony
Orchestra under the direction of E. Svetlanov. He collaborated with
several Moscow orchestras, among which are: the Russian State
Radio Symphony Orchestra (under the direction of V. Fedoseev),
the Bolshoy Theater and the Moscow Symphony Orchestra.

In February 1998, he joined the Moscow Chamber Orchestra in the violas section. Since March 1999 and is currently a member of the Royal Philharmonic of Galicia as a viola. Since 2002 he worked as a violin and viola teacher at the Charamela Music School in Pontedeume. He also collaborated as a chamber music teacher at the School of Higher Musical Studies in Santiago de Compostela.

He participate in numerous chamber music festivals, both in Galicia and in Spain and Europe. He collaborated with orchestras such as the Castilla y León Symphony Orchestra, RTVE, the Galician Symphony Orchestra and the Barcelona and National Symphony Orchestra of Catalonia.
